



Temporary Duty Peace Corps Medical Officer U.S. Peace Corps, Pretoria

U.S. Peace Corps seeks a medical practitioner or nurse practitioner, with qualifications in primary health care and independent practice experience, to serve as a temporary duty contracted Peace Corps Medical Officer (TDY PCMO). The TDY PCMO provides health care to approximately 180 Peace Corps Volunteers and works under the supervision of the head Peace Corps Medical Officer.

Duties include:

- Routine primary health care to Peace Corps Trainees and Volunteers such as addressing common illnesses and injuries in accordance with accepted professional standards
- Individual short-term counseling on disease prevention, stress management and cross-cultural problems
- Design and development of health and safety training sessions
- Maintain Inventory of medical supplies and equipment
- Response to emergency situations
- Administrative tasks of the medical office
- On call duty

Qualifications & Requirements

- Grad of BSN, grad of master's program as nurse practitioner or a physician's assistant or a medical degree from an accredited medical school
- Valid license to practice from the HPCSA
- At least 5 yrs experience in a professional practice, hospital or clinic setting
- Level IV speaking/reading English
- Working knowledge of MS word, excel, access, outlook
- Ability to work with foreign nationals
- Willingness to travel
- Good communication and leadership skills would be an advantage
