## The Power of Partnerships

In fiscal year 2009, the PEPFAR program in South Africa, with over 500 prime and sub-partners, will work toward achieving the September 2012 targets, which are to treat 3 million HIV-infected people, prevent 12 million new infections, and care for 12 million HIV-infected and affected individuals. Along with the long-term 2012 targets is the immediate need to work closely with the South African Government (SAG) in an effort to support and enhance the goals of *The HIV & AIDS and STI Strategic Plan for South Africa, 2007-2011* (NSP). PEPFAR Partners work in collaboration with the SAG in the following technical areas: Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission (PMTCT), Prevention of Sexual Transmission, Blood Safety, Injection Safety, Male Circumcision, Counseling & Testing, Adult & Pediatric Care & Support, TB/HIV, Orphans & Vulnerable Children, ARV Drugs, Adult & Pediatric Treatment, Laboratory Infrastructure, Strategic Information, Health Systems Strengthening, Human Capacity Development, and Monitoring & Evaluation.
