- A blog is about three things: frequency, brevity, and personality
- Publishing is easy; no need to learn HTML.

How to Write Your Own Weblog

- Use a free Web-based Weblog service, such as Blogger, <http://www.blogger.com>
- The content can be entered in plain text – and design templates are available
- You can maintain the Weblog from any computer that's connected to the Internet
- There is no need to have special servers or software installed on your computer

What is RSS?

- *Really Simple Syndication*
- RSS is an eXtensible Markup Language, XML-based format for syndicating news and content
- RSS allows you to create your own personal news wire, using “RSS feeds”

You'll Need a Newsreader or News Aggregator

RSS readers or aggregators can be Web-based or downloaded to your computer's hard drive.

Most Weblogs, News Sites and Many E-zines Have RSS Feeds

How to make a resource part of your RSS personalized news wire

- Look for the XML link in the resource you want, for example, The Resource Shelf, <http://www.resourceshelf.com>
- Find the link for XML or RSS
- Click on it
- Save the URL
- Paste it into the RSS reader's "add channel" form

Using Your Newsreader's Database to Add News Feeds

- Most newsreaders have a way for you to search for a title that you want to follow
- For example, let's say you want to follow the news headlines from the Washington Post.
- Simply search your newsreader's database for Washington Post and add the resource to your list.
